- 3. Each essay will earn a blue, red or white ribbon.
- 4. The score on the essay will provide bonus points in selecting our 4-H'er of the Year winners.
 - (Blue) Excellent Essay 20 bonus points
 - (Red) Good Essay 10 bonus points
 - (White) Fair Essay 5 bonus points
- 5. 1st 3rd place medalists will be selected in each grade division: Junior (4th-5th), Jr. High (6th-8th), and Sr. High (9th 12th).
