It's important to save money so you can buy or do the things you want in the future. Use your creativity to make a Piggy Bank to hold the money you save!

- Get ideas and help securing supplies from your parents/guardian, but do the work on your bank yourself.
- 2. Your bank can be ANYTHING! Use your imagination.
- 3. You can make your bank from anything -- plastic bottles, boxes, milk jugs, cans, etc. NO GLASS.
- 4. Banks should be no larger than 12" X 12" X 12".
- 5. There should be a way to both put the money in and easily get it out without destroying the bank.
- 6. Be sure to make your bank sturdy enough to be carried or moved around without coming apart.
- 7. Write your name, grade and school on the bottom of your bank.

Register at https://tiny.utk.edu/4Hbank and then upload three pictures of your bank (front of bank, location where money goes in, location where money comes out) into your 4-H Google Classroom by February 15. Each bank will earn a blue, red or white ribbon. Banks will be judged on general appearance (25%), creativity (25%), construction (25%), and functionality (25%)

Top entries in each division will be selected as finalists. In March, finalists will turn in their banks to be displayed at community locations with 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medalists selected for each grade division: Jr (4th-5th grade), Jr High (6th-8th grade), and Sr. High (9th-12th grade).
