

Poster Art Contest - February 1

Students in 4th - 12th grade are invited to make a poster that promotes 4-H.

1. Register at <https://tiny.utk.edu/4Hposter> and upload a picture of your completed poster to your 4-H Google Classroom by **February 1**.
2. Only one 4-H'er may work on a poster. It cannot be submitted as a team. One entry per member.
3. The poster must be made on white or colored poster board (not foam board, not art paper, etc.).
4. The poster must be 14" tall x 22" wide and used horizontally. A standard sheet of poster board is 28x22 inches. When you cut it in half, it will be the correct size for your poster (14" tall x 22" wide).
5. You can use any technique to create your poster such as paint, markers, pencil, etc. You can use pre-cut words or shapes. Make sure items are attached securely. Nothing can stick out farther than 1/8".
6. Your poster must use the word "4-H" or the have the 4-H clover on the poster. The clover must be upright, stem must be turned to the right and nothing can be in front of the clover.
7. Your poster should have a short, catchy title or theme and artwork to illustrate your idea.
8. Do not use well-known cartoon characters, such as Spiderman®, because these are copyrighted.
9. Put your name, address, phone, school and current grade **ON THE BACK OF THE POSTER**.
10. Each poster will earn a blue, red or white ribbon.
11. Finalists will turn in their posters to be judged for top honors. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medalists will be selected for each grade and their posters will be displayed during the month of March.
12. The top overall poster will be used for this year's 4-H t-shirt and will include the student's name and school.
