Poster Art Contest - February 1

Students in 4th - 12th grade are invited to make a poster that promotes 4-H.

- Register at https://tiny.utk.edu/4Hposter and upload a picture of your competed poster to your 4-H Google Classroom by February 1.
- 2. Only one 4-H'er may work on a poster. It cannot be submitted as a team. One entry per member.
- 3. The poster must be made on white or colored poster board (not foam board, not art paper, etc.).
- 4. The poster must be 14" tall x 22" wide and used horizontally. A standard sheet of poster board is 28x22 inches. When you cut it in half, it will be the correct size for your poster (14" tall x 22" wide).
- 5. You can use any technique to create your poster such as paint, markers, pencil, etc. You can use pre-cut words or shapes. Make sure items are attached securely. Nothing can stick out farther than 1/8".
- 6. Your poster must use the word "4-H" or the have the 4-H clover on the poster. The clover must be upright, stem must be turned to the right and nothing can be in front of the clover.
- 7. Your poster should have a short, catchy title or theme and artwork to illustrate your idea.
- 8. Do not use well-known cartoon characters, such as Spiderman[®], because these are copyrighted.
- 9. Put your name, address, phone, school and current grade ON THE BACK OF THE POSTER.
- 10. Each poster will earn a blue, red or white ribbon.
- 11. Finalists will turn in their posters to be judged for top honors. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medalists will be selected for each grade and their posters will be displayed during the month of March.
- 12. The top overall poster will be used for this year's 4-H t-shirt and will include the student's name and school.
